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We provide a light snack for Morning Tea during BSC and Afternoon Tea during Term time but it is not a full meal so we do urge parents to provide Breakfast before attending and a full lunch for the day. During Vacation Care we cater Morning Tea, Lunch and Afternoon Tea most days unless otherwise specified for large full day excursions.

Session Costs

BSC: \$ 21.50

ASC: \$31.00

Vacation Care: \$84 per day

Additional costs are applied to Casual sessions. Child Care Subsidy (CCS) applies to these charges if you wish to claim CCS with Centrelink.

Before School Care 6.45am to 9am (2.25 hours)

After School Care 3:00pm – 6:00pm (3 hours)

Vacation Care/Pupil Free Days 6.45am – 6:00pm (11.25 hours)

EHOSHC Before and After School Care provides a variety of experiences each day for children in Prep through to year 6 from 6.45am to 9am and 3pm to 6pm. We have an extensive selection of art, craft, sandpit, construction, dramatic play, games, sports activities, and much much more on offer each day.

Our program is planned each day around the children's needs, interests and abilities from information which our educators, families and the children themselves provide. Children are able to select each day which activities they would like to participate in. We also utilize many areas throughout the school including the undercover area, playgrounds, basketball courts and the oval.

Vacation Care programs and booking forms for each holiday will be available 4 weeks prior to the Vacation Care period to Edge Hill families. We do accept children from other schools 2 weeks before the holidays to allow our current families a grace period for booking.

Enrolment

We open enrolments to our current families in Week 3 of Term 4 each year to re - enrol for the following year, we then open up enrolments for new families in Week 5 of Term 4. Current families must re - enrol their child and request a new booking each year as bookings do not rollover.

Once your enrolment has been submitted you will need to create or link an Xplor account. To claim CCS you will need to open your MyGov account and accept an enrolment with us for your CCS to be applied.
