

Edge Hill State School follows the Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) and Restorative Practices philosophy. Specialist Programs

May require a specific uniform – Supervisors of these programs will notify parents and uniforms can be loaded to students.

Sport Uniform – House colour T-shirt. Maroon shorts. Worn on sports day only

Swimming –swim shirts

Jewellery – Permitted items

One watch (smart watch must be set to school mode)

One discreet religious necklace

Small sleepers or studs

Hair – Neatly groomed

Long hair tied back with discreet hair ties (boys and girls)

Ribbons – Edge Hill colours maroon & gold

Jumpers – Plain, preferably black or maroon

Not Permitted

Hats – caps

Shoes – open toed sandals, thong, crocs

Socks -bright, knee length

Jewellery - Beads, shells, chains and/or facial adornment are not suitable for school. Students will be asked to remove inappropriate jewelry. This jewellery will be held for parent collection.

Hair – Large hair ties, head bands or clips with adornments, coloured hair spray or dyed hair.

Make up – No make up is appropriate for school including false eyelashes, false nails or nail polish.

Jumpers – No insignia, patterns or inappropriate designs



It is an expectation of the Edge Hill State School Community - the Parents' & Citizens Association (P & C), the Principal and staff - that all students abide by the School Dress Code Policy.

A parent/caregiver application to enrol at Edge Hill State School is taken as acceptance of this policy.

Custody/Parenting Arrangements

Information regarding your family circumstances is essential to help us to understand and support your child while at school. A copy of a court order or custody order is necessary so that school staff can help ensure the legally designated parent or guardian collects children.

Under the law, schools must monitor attendance of students and follow up unexplained absences with parents and caregivers. Your child must attend school **ALL** school days unless you have a reasonable excuse. You must not keep your child away from school for minor reasons. Education Queensland policy is that all student absences must be accounted for. Parents/guardians must telephone the school or provide a written note explaining the reason for absence, emails should be addressed office@edgehillss.eq.edu.au. A record is made of your call and all notes are kept on file. Unexplained absences are marked accordingly. Teachers or administrators will contact families where children are absent without explanation.

First Aid/Medication

First Aid

Members of our school staff are permitted only to render basic First Aid. This is immediate, temporary treatment given by the staff in case of an accident. Should medical treatment beyond First Aid be required, parents are notified immediately whenever possible and/or the necessary treatment arranged. In case of a serious accident, an ambulance will be called to transport the injured child to a doctor or hospital.

Administration of Medications

All medication to be taken by children at school should be brought to the School Administration Office to be administered under the supervision of the Administration team. Parents must bring medication to the office and complete the 'Permission to Administer Medication'.

Please note, school staff will only administer medication that:

- has been prescribed by a qualified health practitioner (e.g. doctor, dentist)
- is in its original container
- has an attached pharmacy label

All medication **must be labelled** in the name of the child with a pharmacy prescribed label. This includes; cough medicines, Ventolin and Aspirin, Disprin, eardrops etc. No medicines can be accepted without a completed 'Permission to Administer Medication' authorisation from the parents/guardian. *Non-prescribed oral medications (such as Panadol) should **not** be brought to school and will **not** be administered by any staff.*

Parents are to advise the School Administration Office of details of any children who self-administer approved medication. e.g., medications for Asthma, Diabetes and Epilepsy.

Information for medical specialists

If your child is seeing an external specialist who requests that the school or teacher provide information or complete an assessment for your child please follow the steps below.

1. Please provide the request for information/assessment in writing to the Deputy Principal for Learning and Inclusion – Mrs Kirsty Edwards kedwa51@eq.edu.au. Please do not contact the class teacher directly.
2. Please provide the following details:
 - Name and specialty of the provider seeking the information
 - Email address and phone number of the specialist seeking the information
 - Date of appointment or date that information is required. Please allow a minimum of two week's notice.
3. Before providing information to the specialist, the school will require you to complete and return a **consent form for sharing of information with external providers**
4. If the specialist requires the school/teacher to complete an online form or assessment, the school will provide you with a **third-party website consent form** which must be also be completed and signed. Please note that the school is required to keep a copy of any information provided via a third-party website.
5. Please note that any requested information is provided directly to the requesting specialist.

Mobile phones and smart watches

Edge Hill is a **device free school** and mobile phones should not be brought to school. In the case of walking or riding to school and parents require their child to have one for safety, mobile phones must stay in school bags at all times, until the student is **off school grounds**.

Mobile phones must be turned off upon entering the school premises and not turned on until after 3:00pm dismissal. Failure to comply with this expectation can result in the phone being taken and parents to collect from the office.

Smart watches must be set to school mode during the school day. The school is not responsible for damage or theft of mobile phones or smart watches that are brought to school.

The Qld government has now imposed a full ban which commenced in Term 1 2024 – mobile phones to be ‘away for the day’.

Teachers are available for prearranged, individual meetings with parents and their child to discuss the student's individual achievement and learning needs. Your teacher will send home a preference form for you to fill in prior to the interviews and advise you of your time. Please ensure you note the day and time and be prompt for this meeting.

Student Reports – twice per year

Formal reporting is completed for all students in late June and early December each year. Report cards are emailed home in the last week of the school term.
